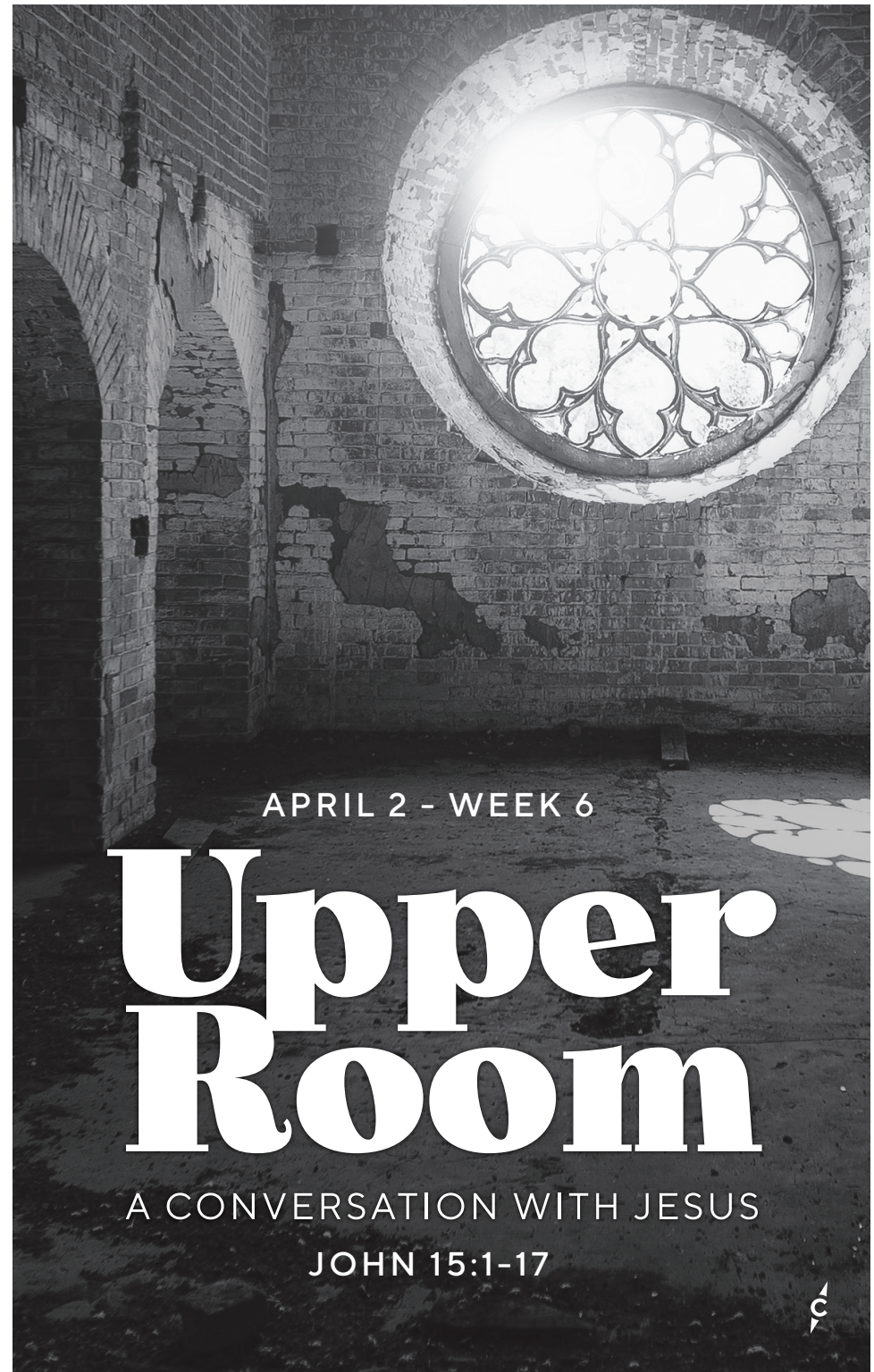

3. What are some “false vines” we attach ourselves to other than Christ?

## THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

Read John 15:1-17 and consider the following questions.

4. What does Jesus’ statement about being the “true vine” imply?
5. What do you feel the metaphors of branches, pruning and fruit represent in these verses?
6. Why do you think Jesus brings his disciples this teaching just before he heads to the cross?

7. How is this teaching related to the joy that Jesus mentions in verse 11?
8. Put yourself in the disciples’ shoes. How do Jesus’ words in verses 15-17 make you feel?

## COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

9. Are there any false vines in your life you need to let go of to embrace the True Vine?
10. Can you identify any areas in your life where you sense the Lord might be pruning you right now?
11. Jesus calls you “friend.” What aspects of friendship can you both receive and offer to him this week?
