CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

1. What was the town or city you grew up in like? Were there things you liked and disliked about it?
2. What are some advantages and disadvantages about using your spiritual gifts around people who watched you grow up or are very familiar with you?
3. Has there ever been a sermon, conversation, devotional, book, etc. that has left a lasting imprint on your life?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

4. Read Luke 4:14-30. What do verses 14-15 tell us about Jesus' earliest deeds in Galilee?
5. In verses 16-21, Jesus reads scripture from Isaiah 61:1-2. What words or phrases stand out to you from what Jesus read?
6. In verse 22, the people seem to go from faith to doubt. Why do you think they reacted this way?

7. What is Jesus trying to communicate in Luke 4:25-27, with his references to Elijah and the widow at Zarephath (1 Kings 17), and Elisha and Naaman the Syrian (2 Kings 5)?
8. Why do you think the people responded with such emotion in verses 28-29?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

9. In contrast with what we see in Luke 4:28-30, what would a healthy, godly response to Jesus' teaching look like?
10. What are some ways we can live out the good news of the Gospel found in the teaching of Jesus in our context?
11. Who is someone familiar to you that you could encourage in their ministry this week?
