## THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

Turn to Ezekiel Chapter 8 and consider the following questions.

4. Read Ezekiel 8:1. Why do you think Ezekiel includes such specific detail in his writing?
5. Read Ezekiel 8:2-3. Where did the Spirit take Ezekiel in his vision, and why might this be so significant?
6. Read Ezekiel 8:4-16. In verse 5, verses 10-11, verse 14 and verse 16 Ezekiel is shown four “detestable things”. What were they and why were they detestable to the Lord?

7. Read verses 17-18. What emotions do these verses evoke in your heart?

8. If the Lord were to show us some “detestable” things in the context of our culture, where might he take us?
9. How does our relationship with Jesus make these verses we just read more comforting?
10. Spend some time in silence and allow the Holy Spirit to reveal any areas in your heart where God might be calling you to confess and repent. As you do, receive his grace and forgiveness.
