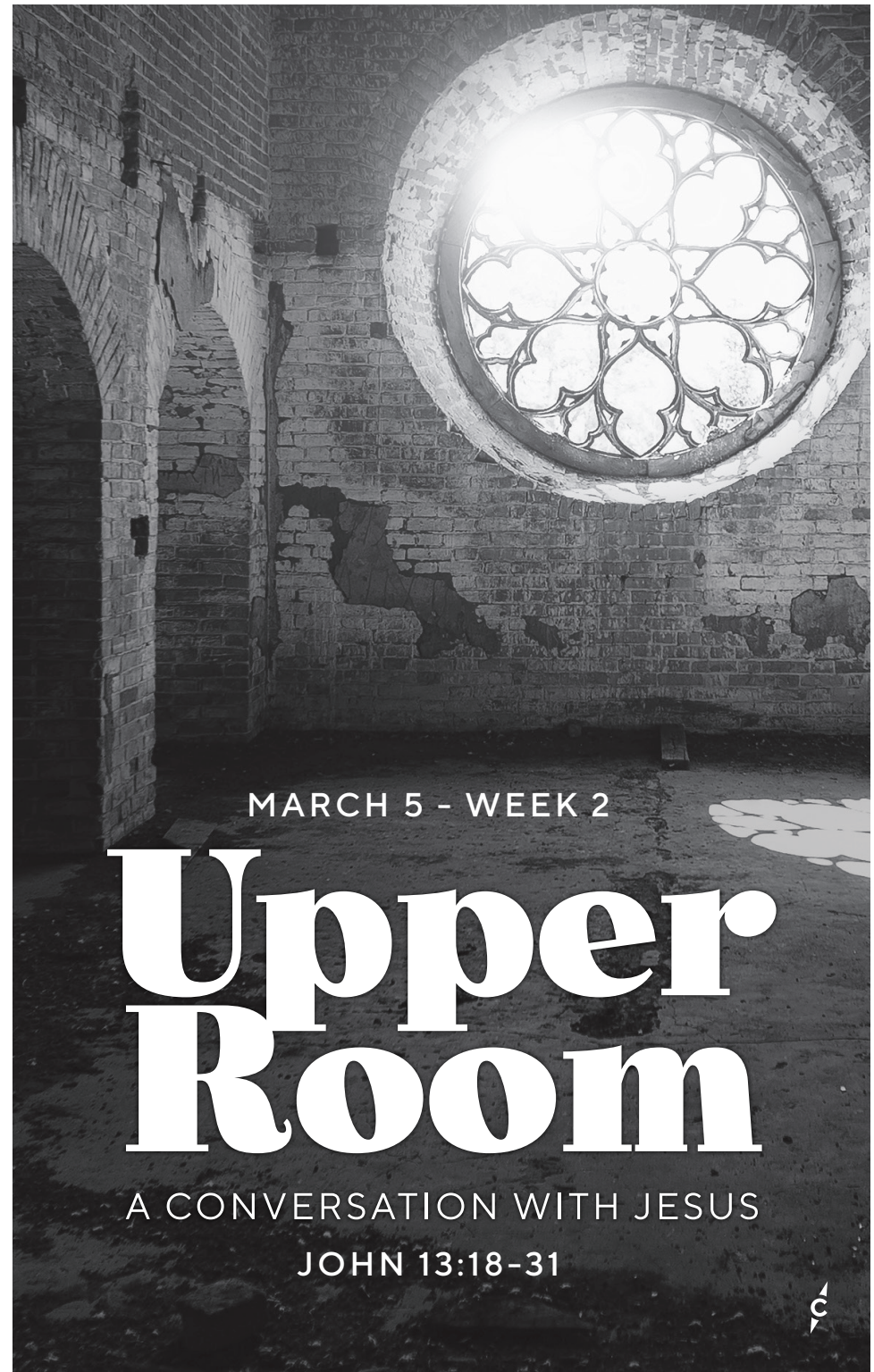

A CONVERSATION WITH JESUS

JOHN 13:18-31



CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

1. How did your parents get your attention when you were in trouble growing up?
2. Have you ever been betrayed by someone you thought was a friend? If you are comfortable, share what that felt like.
3. What external pressures can lead to people betraying one another?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

Read John 13:18-30 and discuss the following.

4. Put yourself into this scene. What about Jesus' words, demeanor or actions would have caught his disciples' attention?
5. Read Psalm 41:9. Why do you think Jesus referenced the Psalm instead of just saying what he wanted to say?
6. Read verse 21. Are there any hints in this verse that might indicate how Jesus was feeling? Why do you think he felt that way?

7. When asked who his betrayer was, why do you think Jesus answered the way he did in verse 26 rather than just calling Judas out?
8. How could someone so close to Jesus betray him? What might have motivated Judas?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

9. What are some ways we can keep our relationship with Jesus vibrant and protect our hearts toward him from getting hard?
10. What are some ways we might "betray" Jesus in our daily lives?
11. Are you willing to receive forgiveness from Jesus in those places?

PAUSE, PONDER & PRAY
