CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

Power gifts demonstrate the power, presence and reality of God. (Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues, Intercession, **Prophecy, Faith, Discernment of Spirits**, Words of Knowledge, Healing, Miracles)

- 1. In what ways have you experienced and are you experiencing the power-generating presence of the Holy Spirit in your life?
- 2. Recall a time when someone told you to 'just have faith'. What was your response?
- 3. There can be tension between gifts operating side by side and even tension between people with the same gifts. What potential points of tension can you see with the Power gifts.

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. Read Acts 5:1-11. This passage is an example of Peter discerning spirits. Ananias and Sapphira were likely moved by Barnabas' example in the previous verses. The difference was motivation. Why do you think these verses are included in this book? What does this passage teach you about the Holy Spirit?
- 5. Read Acts 2:17-18 and Acts 21:8-11. How do these passages contribute to our understanding of the spiritual gift of prophecy? What role does the Holy Spirit play in the passages? Re-read the passage about Agabus and continue reading Paul's response. What aspect of this historical account impacts you most?

- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 14:3 and 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What are the benefits of prophecy, when it is used properly? What is the difference between prophecy and Scripture? The spiritual gift of teaching is the ability to understand and communicate Scripture. How is the gift of teaching different from the gift of prophecy?
- 7. Read 1 Corinthians 14:29-30 and 1 Thessalonians 5:20-21. Why does prophecy need to be tested? Discuss how to test a prophetic word.

COMMIT (BEON MISSION)

- 8. Recall and share an experience when you or another used the gift of prophecy to tell the will of God. How did you respond? Now that you have learned more about this gift, is there something you intend to do differently when a similar experience occurs again?
- 9. Do you know someone with the gift of faith? How might someone with this gift bless and individual or the church?
- 10. Pray that God will guide you and your group as you examine truth and ponder more during this week about the spiritual gifts. Pray that your group, family and friends will be a safe place to practice and nurture spiritual gifts.
