

CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

- 1. Where is a favourite place you have or spend time in that you would describe as "heavenly"?
- 2. What comes to mind when you think of heaven and what it might be like?
- 3. For those who do not believe in heaven, what other anchors might they put their hope in?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

Read John 14:1-14.

- 4. Jesus starts this portion of his conversation with the words, "Do not let your hearts be troubled." What things from chapter 13 might be "troubling" the disciple's hearts?
- 5. Why do you think Jesus used the language of "house" and "rooms" to describe heaven in verse 2?
- 6. What promises does Jesus make in verses 3-4, and what comfort might they have brought to the disciples?

- 7. What foundational theological truth does Jesus make in verses 6-7?
- 8. The word "believe" shows up in verses 10,11 and 12. In what ways does belief play a role in the things Jesus is talking about in these verses?
- 9. What do you think Jesus meant by the term "greater things" in verse 12?

COMMIT (BEON MISSION)

- 10. What "troubling" things in your heart today can the promise of heaven speak peace to?
- 11. How does it make you feel that Jesus has personally prepared a room just for you?
- 12. Knowing that Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in him, what is something significant you can ask the Father for in Jesus' name?
