2 Corinthians 5:7 says that God's people "walk by faith, not by sight" and in Hebrews chapter 11 we find the "Faith Hall of Fame." THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

4. What surprised, challenged or inspired you about the faith of the person we considered in this week's message?

5. What does their faith tell us about how they viewed God?
6. Hebrews 11:1 says, "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." How do you see this verse evident in the story of this person?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

7. Is there something in your life story right now or the life of someone you know that resembles in some way the story we looked at this week? Explain how.
8. What step of faith could you take this week to show your trust in and dependence on God?
9. Pray for an increase of faith for at least one other person in your life today!
