WEEK 4 TALKING POINTS

CONNECT (BUILD RELATIONSHIPS)

- 1. What has been the most meaningful gift you have ever received? Have you ever received a strange or awkward gift? Explain
- 2. When have you felt that you were part of a division, unit, or a team where all the parts worked together for a common goal? Describe.
- 3. Are spiritual gifts something that you are attentive to in others and that you recognize and foster in yourself?

THRIVE (EXPLORE BIBLICAL TRUTH)

- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 12:8-10. Paul lists a number of spiritual gifts that God gives through the Holy Spirit. What is one of your spiritual gifts? If you are unsure, what would those in your group, family or friend circle say might be your spiritual gifts?
- 5. Have you ever received a blessing from someone else from this list of gifts mentioned in this text?
- 6. Read Ephesians 4:11-13. Discuss how you think these roles contribute uniquely to the "building up" of the body of Christ
- 7. Read 2 Timothy 1:6. How do we "fan into flames" the gifts God gives us?
- 8. Read Ephesians 5:15-17. How might these verses apply to the conversation of spiritual gifts?

COMMIT (BE ON MISSION)

- 9. Take a moment to reflect on one spiritual gift you recognize in your group members, family or friends. Tell them why you appreciate this gift in them.
- 10. Are there some gifts that you have been given but have neglected? Why do you think you have neglected them? What could be done to stir up or rekindle them in you?
- 11. As you think about our church and the church at large, which spiritual gifts do you think are most effectively functioning right now? Which are most needed? Is there anything you can do to help meet those needs?
